4. Strong Meat is for those trained by the Word.	Heb 5:12-14
5. Growing from baby to young man to father.	1 John 2:11-14
6. Continue in the Word to be set free.	John 8:31-32
7. Cultivate a good heart to receive the Word.	Mark 4:14-20

1. Diligently seek God.	Heb 11:6
2. Pursue the Word – renew the mind.	2 Tim 2:15; Rom 12:2
3. Hearing and doing the Word - purify the heart.	Matt 7:24-27
4. Be a hearer and doer – deliver the soul.	Jam 1:21-25
F. Living by the Word of God	
1. Receive with meekness the engrafted Word.	James 1:21
2. Submit to God, resist the devil.	James 4:7
3. One step at a time – draw near to God.	James 4:8
4. Hear & do, read & do, study & do.	John 14:21,23
