- 1. Webster: To adore; to pay divine honors to; to reverence with supreme respect and veneration. Adoration: consists in external homage, accompanied with the highest reverence. It is used for the act of praying, or preferring requests or thanksgiving, to the Supreme Being.

- 3. Greek: To kiss, to reverence.
