• By Inheritance. Heb 1:1-4

• By Conferral (Bestowal). Phil 2:9-10; 1 Cor 15:27

• By Conquest. Eph 4:9; Col 2:12-15; Heb 2:14

c) You must have faith in the Name of Jesus. Acts 3:1-7, 16

a)	God manifested in flesh.	John 1:1,14; Col 2:9-10
b)	All authority in Heaven and Earth.	Matt 28:18
c)	The keys of hell and death.	Rev 1:18
d)	At the Name, every knee shall bow.	Phil 2:9-10
e)	The Name is above every other name.	Eph 1:21
f)	Exceeding greatness of power on our behalf.	Eph 1:19

(3) The Name Belongs to the Believer

b)	Whatever you ask the Father in my Name.	John 16:23
c)	Ask in my Name that the Father be glorified.	John 14:13
d)	In my Name, lay hands on the sick.	Mark 16:17-18
e)	All power has been given to me; Therefore, you go.	Matt 28:18-20

(4) Authority in the Name of Jesus

a)	Power and authority.	Luke 10:19
b)	Greater things shall you do.	John 14:12
c)	Where two agree Jesus agrees.	Matt 18:18-20
d)	Whatever you desire, ask; Jesus agrees.	Mark 11:23-24
e)	If you ask anything in my Name, I will do it.	John 14:14
f)	In my Name, cast out demons.	Mark 16:15-18

b) The Great Exchange.	2 Cor 1:21; 2 Cor 8:9; Col 2:12-15; Heb 10:10-23; Rom 8:2
c) He is in our midst.	Matt 18:20
d) Ambassadors of Christ.	2 Cor 5:17-20; Eph 6:11-20
