

Patience

Overview: There are three foundational sins which challenge every person. The first sin committed by satan (Isa 14:12-15) and by every person is pride (Gen 3:5). This first sin is followed almost instantly by impatience (Gen 3:6); then immediately afterward comes fear (Gen 3:8). Of these, impatience is primarily a sin of the soul and this deadly sin can cause major challenges. Patience is one of the most important Fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23; Ecclesiastes 7:8) because in your patience you possess your soul (Luke 21:19). Miracles occur through walking in patience (2 Cor 12:12 and Heb 6:12).

A. Definition of Patience

1) Merriam-Webster's Definition: of Patience (noun) = The capacity, 2 Peter 1:6-12; habit or fact of being patient. Patient (adjective) = **Steadfast** 1 Thess 1:3 **despite opposition,** difficulty, or adversity.

2) **Joyful endurance** despite challenges. Col 1:11; James 5:10-11
