## **Advanced Personal Evangelism**

**Overview:** We wrestle not against flesh and blood but against *spiritual powers* (Eph 6:12).

### **A. Prepare Ye the Way** (Matt 3:3)

1. Prepare yourself.
  - a) Fast and pray, hear and obey.
  - b) Know the Salvation Scriptures (John 3:16; Rom 10:9-10; Eph 2:8).
2. Prepare the environment.
  - a) Bind satan and his demons/evil spirits and cast them out (Mark 16:15-19).
  - b) Loose the Will of God and His angels into that place (Matt 18:18).
3. Prepare the subject.
  - a) Bind all demons/evil spirits including religious ones from influencing the ministeree.
  - b) Pray that the Holy Spirit touch his/her heart and open his/her ears and eyes.

### **B. Ministering in Spirit and in Truth** (John 4:24).

1. Minister from your heart, not your mind (Prov 4:23).
  - a) Minister from the Word and with testimonies, not with mental reasons.
  - b) The Word of God is a seed (1 Pet 1:23); and a sword (Heb 4:12).
2. Minister through the Fruit of the Spirit (Gal 5:22-23).
  - a) Minister in peace, joy, patience and gentleness (2 Tim 2:24-26).
3. Minister through the Gifts of the Spirit (1 Cor 12:4-11).
  - a) The power of God is in the Gospel (Rom 1:16) – use it.
  - b) Obey authority and the spiritual laws of God will work for you (1 Tim 2:2).

### **C. Become All things unto All** (1 Cor 9:22).

1. Meet the ministeree where s/he is.
  - a) Look for points of agreement, **not** disagreements.
2. Speak in love, not in self-righteousness nor judgment.
3. Esteem the other more than yourself.
  - a) Respect their desires, intentions, hopes, plans, thoughts, words and actions more than your own (Phil 2:3).
  - b) Let the Word of God change them and correct them (2 Tim 3:16).

### **D. Be a Hedge of Protection afterwards** (Eze 22:30).

1. Be a watchman for the ministeree (Eze 23:17).
2. Add the ministeree to your daily prayer list for protection, blessings and revelation.
3. Recommend attending church and reading the Bible daily.

**Recommendation:** Pray daily that God will prepare you and lead you to those who are ready to hear the Good News of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
