

The Anointing

Overview: The anointing is the presence of the Spirit of God, manifested for a purpose.

A. What is the anointing?

1 Old Testament:

- God would anoint the king to stand in that office. 1 Sam 16:13
- Anointing on the priest. Lev 8:12
- Anointing on the prophet. 1 Kings 19:16,19

2 New Testament

- The power of the Lord present to heal. Luke 5:17
- Speaking the Word results in the anointing to confirm it. Mark 16:20
- Anointing = unction which means smearing. 1 John 2:20, 27

B. Purpose of the anointing?

1. Break the yoke of bondage. Isa 10:27
2. Gifts of the Spirit are given to every man to profit withal. 1 Cor 12:7
3. You are an ambassador of Jesus. Eph 6:19-20

C. Two flows of the anointing

1. Spirit descending and remaining. John 1:33
2. Least in the Kingdom is greater than John. Luke 7:28
3. The anointing abides in you. 1 John 2:27
4. The Word of God which effectually works in you. 1 Thess 2:13

D. Coming under the anointing

1. Confess sins.
 - When we confess, God is faithful and just to forgive. 1 John 1:9
 - Confess your faults one to another. James 5:16
2. Study the Word.
 - The Word of his grace, which is able to build you up. Act 20:32
 - Cleansed with the washing of the water of the Word. Eph 5:26
3. Prayer. Acts 1:14; Acts 2:1-4
4. Corporate Anointing.
 - Not forsaking the assembling of yourselves together. Heb 10:25
 - Making melody in your hearts to God, bring a psalm. Eph 5:19; Col 3:16
 - Unity - Glory filled temple. Psalm 133:1-2; 2 Ch 7:1-3
5. Music.
 - David gave his psalm into the hand of Asaph. 1 Chron 16:7; Psalms
 - David danced before the lord. 2 Samuel 6:14
 - Paul and Silas in jail singing. Acts 16:25
6. Lift up holy hands. Psa 63:4; Psa 134:2
