

Angels and Other Celestial Beings

Overview: All angels are celestial beings but not all celestial beings are angels.

A. What are Angels?

- 1. General.
 - Created by God (Psa 148:2-5) before man (Ezek 28:13) for His pleasure (Rev 4:11)
 - Spiritual beings (Heb 1:14); do not marry and do not die (Luke 20:34-36) •
- 2. Specific.

		• Personal beings, looking like a man (not a child/woman).	Judges 6:22; Gen 19:1-8
		• Superhuman intelligence but not omniscient.	Matt 24:36; 1 Pet 1:12
		• Stronger than man.	2 Pet 2:11; 2 Thess 1:7
		• Vast multitudes.	Rev 5:11; Matt 26:53
		• Created holy.	Gen 1:31; Matt 25:31
		• They minister to (serve) the heirs of salvation (mankind).	Heb 1:14; Acts 5:19; 12:7
		• Note: There is no evidence that angels have wings.	Zech 5:8-11

		Cherubims.	
		• Celestial beings with winged human-animal form.	Ezek 10:20-22
		• 2 wings (1Ki 8:7), 2 faces (Ezek 41:18); 4 wings, 4 faces.	Ezek 1: 5-10
		• Each has four faces: cherub, man, lion, eagle.	Ezek 10:14
		• They are associated with the Glory of God.	Ezek 10:4; Heb 9:5
		• They guard the Garden of Eden with a flaming sword.	Gen 3:24
		• Lucifer was an anointed cherub who covers.	Ezek 28:14
	2.	Seraphims.	
		• Celestial beings with three pairs of wings.	Isa 6:1-2
		• They worship God with song in the Throne room.	Isa 6:3-4; Rev 4:6-9
		• Cleansed Isaiah's lips with a hot coal.	Isa 6:5-8
		• Possibly. Seraphims are the four beasts in Revelation:	
		- Associated with the 24 Elders and worship.	Rev 5:8,14
		- They are covered with eyes and have 6 wings.	Rev 4:6,8
		- Each beast with a different face (man, lion, calf, eagle).	Rev 4:7
		- Associated with the opening of the seals.	Rev 6:1
		- Associated with the vials full of the wrath of God.	Rev 15:7

		• Highest rank, oversee angels & do special announcements.	Jude 9; 1 Thess 4:16
	2.	Guardian.	
		• Angel to guard, protect, lead and care for mankind.	Psa 91:11; Matt 18:10
	3. 1	Messenger (e.g., Gabriel).	
		• Angel to send and deliver messages to mankind.	Dan 8:16; 9:21; Luke 1:19,26
		• Obedient to the heirs of salvation thru the spoken Word	Heb 1:14; Psalm 103:20
		and thru praying in tongues (language of angels).	1 Cor 13:1
