satan and his fallen angels

Overview: To enter into and spoil a strong man's house, first bind the strong man. Matt 12:29

A. What is satan?

1. Created being, one place at a time; an anointed cherub, who covers. Ez 28:11-19
2. Lucifer (bearer of light) fell thru pride – the Five “I will’s”. Isa 14:12-15
3. Tempted Adam & Eve (Gen 3:1-8); and Jesus with Kingdoms of this world. Matt 4:3-10
4. Became god of this world; prince of the powers of the air. 2 Cor 4:4; Eph 2:2
5. His character and intentions are shown by his names e.g., Beelzebub Rev 12:7-10
 - a) dragon, serpent, deceiver, accuser, adversary, murderer, father of lies. John 8:44
6. Object of laughter (Isa 14:16), bound for 1000 years (Rev 20:2-3), lake of fire. (Rev 20:10)

B. What are fallen angels?

1. Created angels who chose to follow satan.
 - a) All of the followers of satan are angels. Matt 25:41; Rev 12:4,9
 - b) Gave up the beauty of holiness so are ugly, deformed, horrible due to sin. Psa 29:2
 - c) Invisible but can be seen (2 Kings 6:17) or appear as an angel of light. 2 Cor 11:14
 - d) Can attack only with fiery darts of deceit because Jesus defeated satan. Eph 6:16
 - e) Called devils, not demons, in KJV; NIV missing 29 verses, incl Mark 9:29; 16:15-18
2. They are highly organized.
 - a) Principality, power, might & dominions (Eph 1:21)/rulers & sp wickedness Eph 6:12
 - b) Over areas – geography (country, city, hills esp 5), industry, people, things.
 - c) Have altars, receive worship (Ex 34:13) high places (Lev 26:30) (e.g., pentagram shape).
 - d) Strongholds, imaginations and every ungodly thing. 2 Cor 10:3-5
3. Types of fallen angels.
 - a) devils/demons, spirits (evil Act 19:15, unclean Matt 12:43, familiar (OT), foul Mark 9:25).
 - b) Nephilim (giants) – This kind comes out with the Rivers of Living Water, Mark 9:17-27 (e.g., anointing with prayer and fasting), not just by the Name of Jesus. Matt 17:14-21
 - c) Sin/symptom specific – deaf, dumb, fear, lust, unforgiveness, infirmity Luke 13:11

C. What is cleansing?

1. Removing hindrances between you and Jesus.
 - a) Sins (known and unknown), iniquities, words, devils. 1 John 1:9
 - b) Possessions, people, desires, habits and experiences and words. Matt 10:39
 - c) Recover yourself out of the snare (trap) of the enemy. 2 Tim 2:26
2. Breaking the curses associated with the hindrances Gen 34:3; generational Ex 20:5
3. Casting out the devils behind the curses. Mark 16:17

D. How to guard against their return.

1. Guard your heart and your words. Pro 4:23
2. Cover yourself with the Blood of Jesus by confessing sins immediately/frequently. 1 John 1:9
3. Use the power in the Name of Jesus. Phil 2:10
4. Nothing of the enemy shall by any means hurt you. Luke 10:19
5. Submit yourself to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you. Jam 4:7
